Cabinet Care Suggestions

Caring for your cabinets properly is the most important step to keeping them beautiful throughout the years. We suggest doing the following:

- After installation is complete, wipe the cabinets with a soft, clean cloth dampened with water. Dry immediately with another clean, soft cloth.
- Regular cleaning requires only wiping with a dampened cloth and then drying. Remove oil, grease, or general soil by using a clean cloth dampened with a fresh solution of mild dishwashing soap and warm water. Rinse with a clean cloth dampened with clean water and then dry thoroughly.
- **WARNING:** Excess moisture is one of the worst enemies of any finish. Sink, range, dishwasher, oven and baseboard areas are most susceptible. Promptly remove any water spills and excess moisture from cabinets using a clean, soft cloth.
- Avoid using harsh detergents, strong soaps, abrasive cleaners, or self-polishing waxes when cleaning. Also avoid using ammonia solutions on or near cabinets. The substances could have a deteriorating effect on the finish surface.
- Avoid using a dishcloth to clean or dry cabinets as it may contain remnants of detergent or grease.
- Cover nicks and scratches with a tinted putty stick or touch-up bottle such as the one included in the touch-up kits that are available through your local dealer.
- We do not recommend waxing. Over time, waxing and polishing compounds may build up on the surface causing a hazy, streaky appearance.

Following these guidelines will maximize finish performance and allow you to enjoy your cabinets for many, many years to come.
